What is Women's Center of Yamanashi?

Women's Center of Yamanashi provides comprehensive counseling services and support to women. It also serves as the Domestic Violence Support Service Center to provide safety and support to women affected by domestic violence and abuse.

Services include emergency shelter and independence support counseling.

If you are suffering from:

- Domestic issues
- Divorce or relationship issues
- Domestic violence (physical, emotional, or sexual abuse within married/intimate relationships)
- Uncertainty about the direction of your life, feeling stuck
- A lack of emotional support when in need of advice
- Prostitution (counseling on protection or rehabilitation)
- Abuse by a boyfriend
- Stalking
- Having nowhere to go
