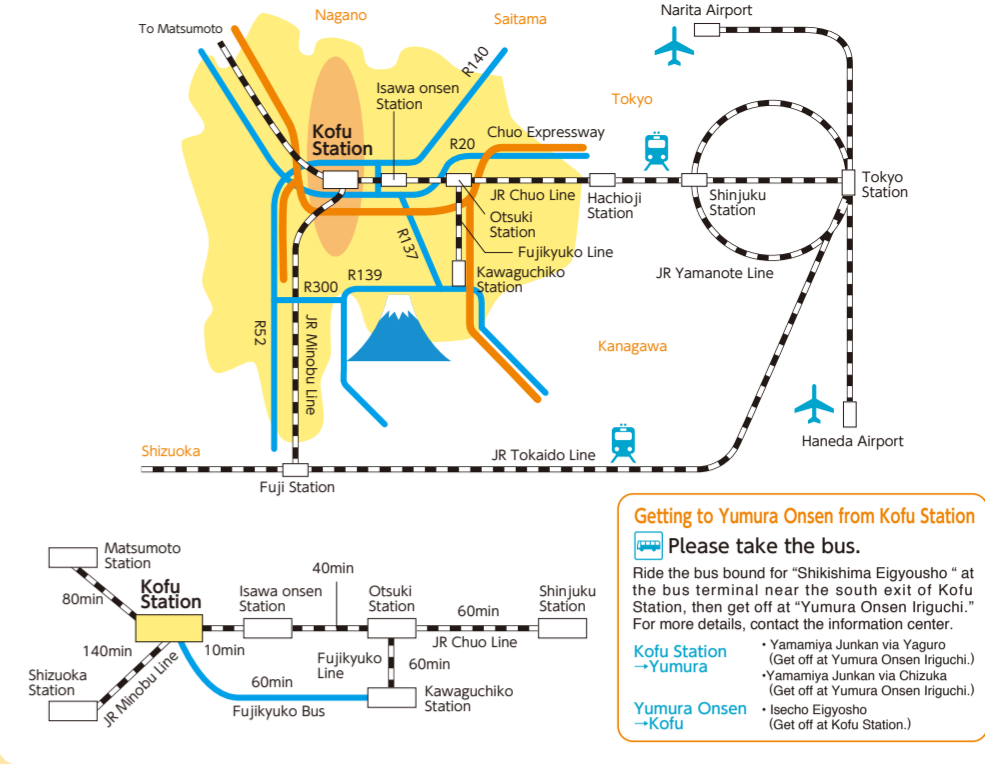

Yumura Onsen Area Recommended Visits!

The History of Yumura Onsen

Many famous people, including author Dazai Osamu, are known to have stayed at Yumura Onsen. The town was established 1,200 years ago. Tradition has it that the hot spring was discovered by Kobo Daishi. At the far end of Yumura Onsen-dori is Entaku-ji Temple, which is dedicated to Yakuyoke Jizo statues made from natural stone by Kobo Daishi. The temple features many Jizo statues and smiling Kobo Daishi Jizo statues.

11 Entaku-ji Temple

Entaku-ji Temple is said to have been founded in 808 by Kobo Daishi. Climbing the stone steps from the front entrance, visitors reach a Jizodo hall containing a statue of Jizo Bosatsu. The Yakuyoke Jizoson festival takes place over a 24-hour period from noon, February 13, to noon, February 14 of each year, during which the Jizo statue is thought to open his ears, listens to people's requests, and cause misfortune to flee. More than 50,000 people attend, and the festival is lively from start to finish.
